



Weather Proof Your Hairstyle

With these tips, your hair will hold up against every weapon of mass hair destruction you can think of -- from pouring rain to blazing heat

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The best thing to do when the weather is dry is to unplug those hot tools. Don't even try to straighten or curl your hair. "When it's dry and scorching out, a ponytail or high bun is another good option," says NYC-based hairstylist Danielle Irene. Start
